



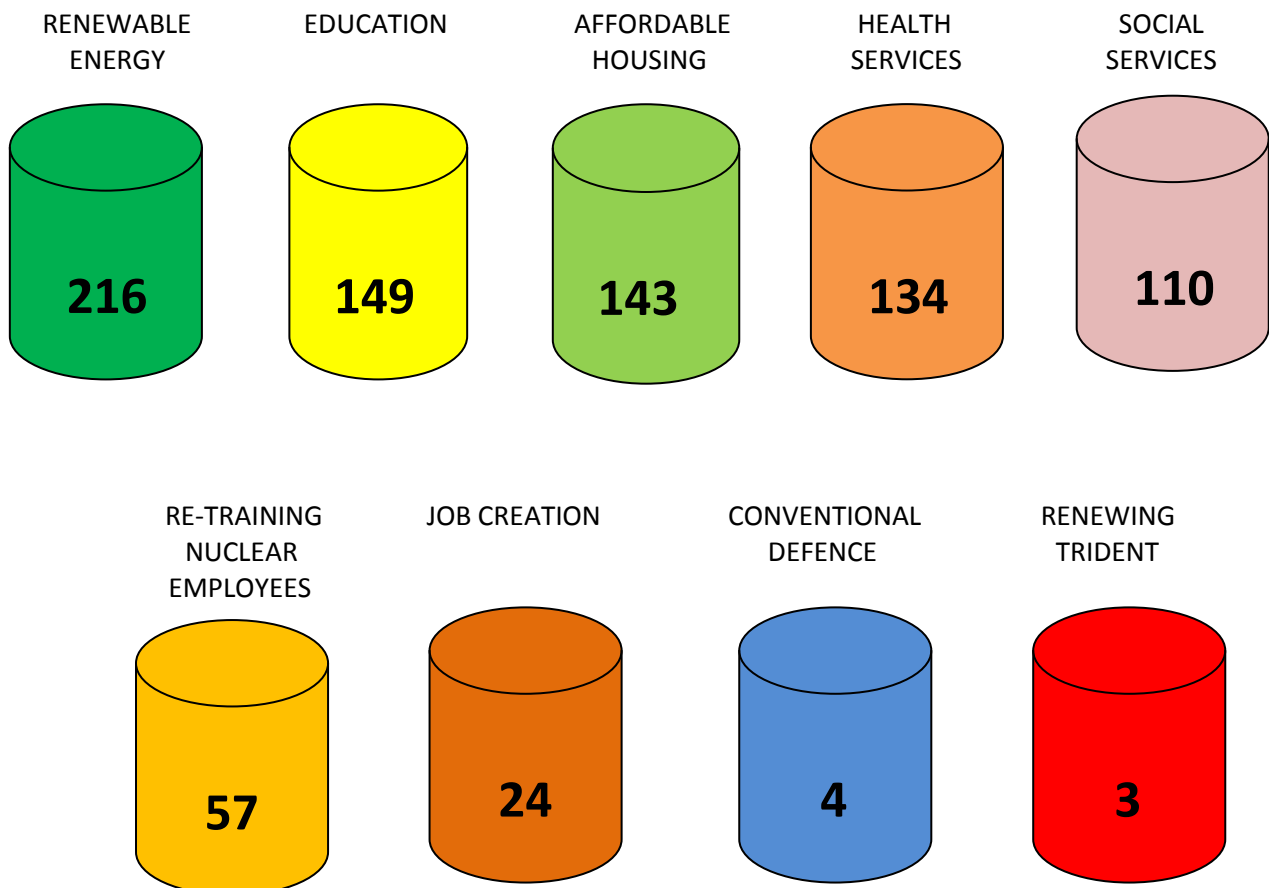
WHAT TO DO WITH TRIDENT MONEY

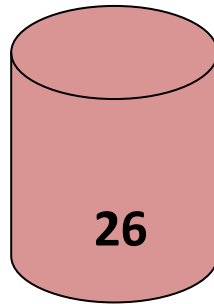
